Good Attendance

As we begin 2019, we would like to bring to your attention the importance of excellent attendance for academic achievement and pastoral benefit. The school target for attendance is 97% and the expectation is that pupils should end the school year with attendance of at least 95%.

Did you know :

90% attendance = four weeks absence from school

Four weeks absence from school = 100 lessons missed in school

DFE research shows lunchtime attendance of 90% would mean a drop of at least a grade in GCSE exams.

We issue half-termly awards for pupils with excellent attendance. In addition, good attendance also contributes to the end of year 'Going for Gold' rewards points, so it is never too late to work on improving attendance. If your child's attendance was below target in 2018, then this New Year is the time for a fresh, new start.

The school would like to say well done to all our pupils with attendance of 98% or above.
