The first person said, "An odd number of us always tell the truth".

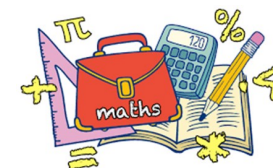
The second person said, "An even number of us always tell the truth".
