**Behaviour and body language reveal a lot about the relationships between people. How is this revealed in a story?**

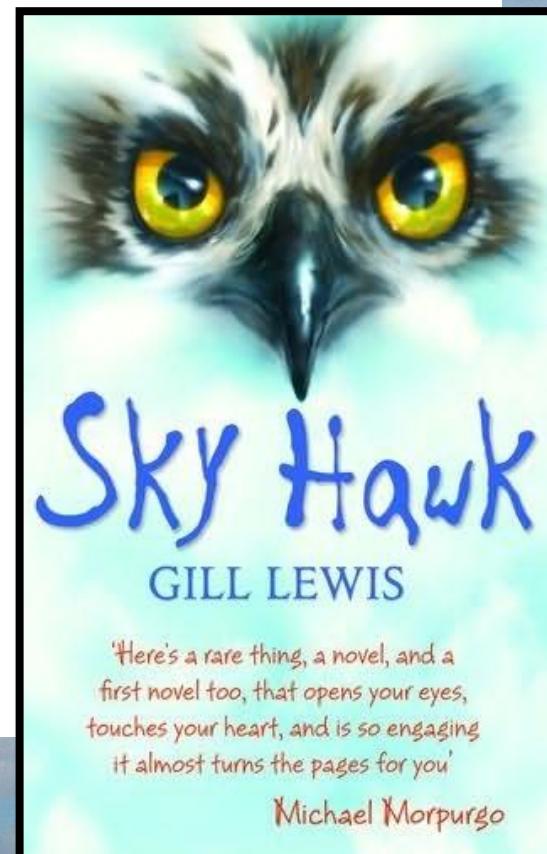
# Input Activity

# Plenary Activity

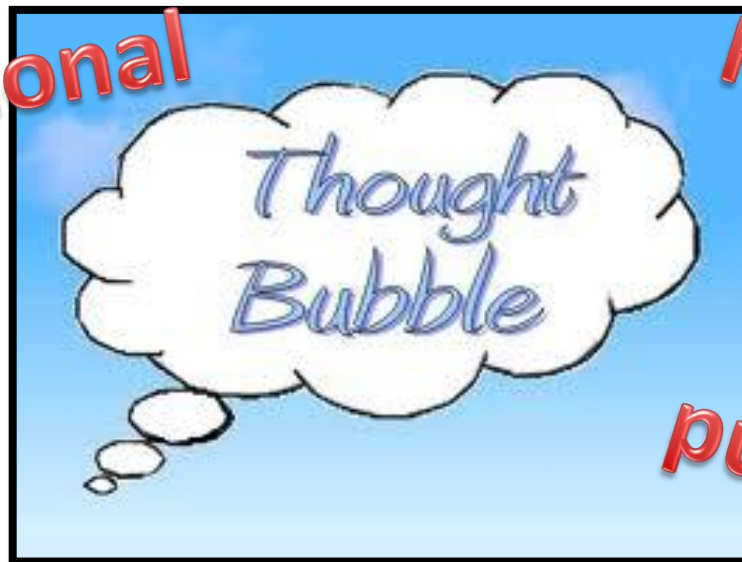


- Imagine someone has shared an amazing secret with you. Write an internal monologue (speech in your head) stating what you have been told and how you feel about it.
