1. Describe how Callum might be feeling in three words.

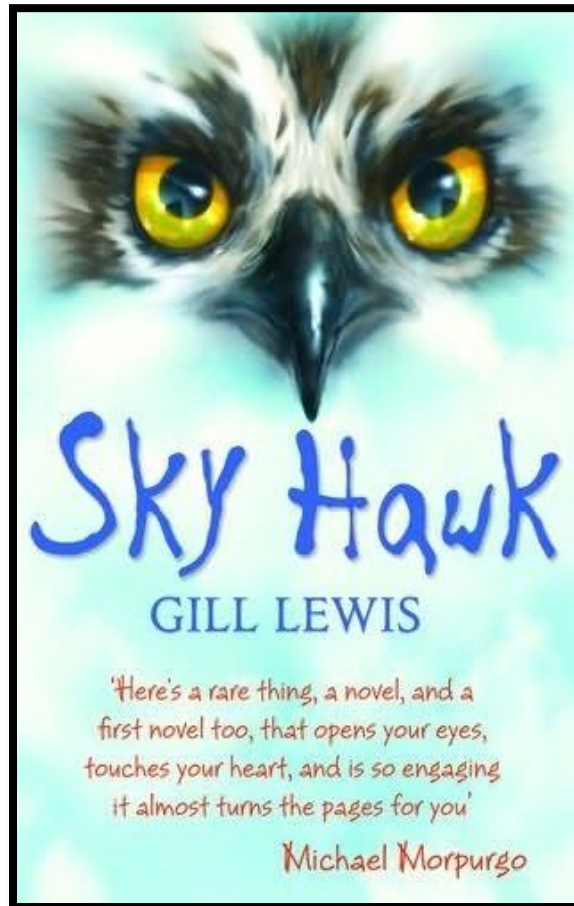
2. Why is Iona so upset by the idea of the osprey being dead?
