Starter Activity



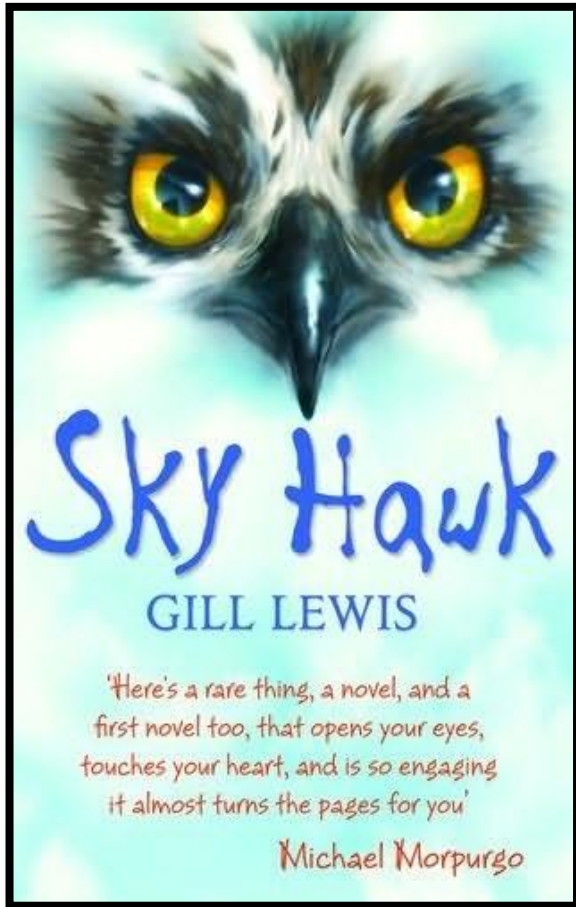
Answer the following questions on Chapter 16 of *Sky Hawk*.

What is Foreshadowing?

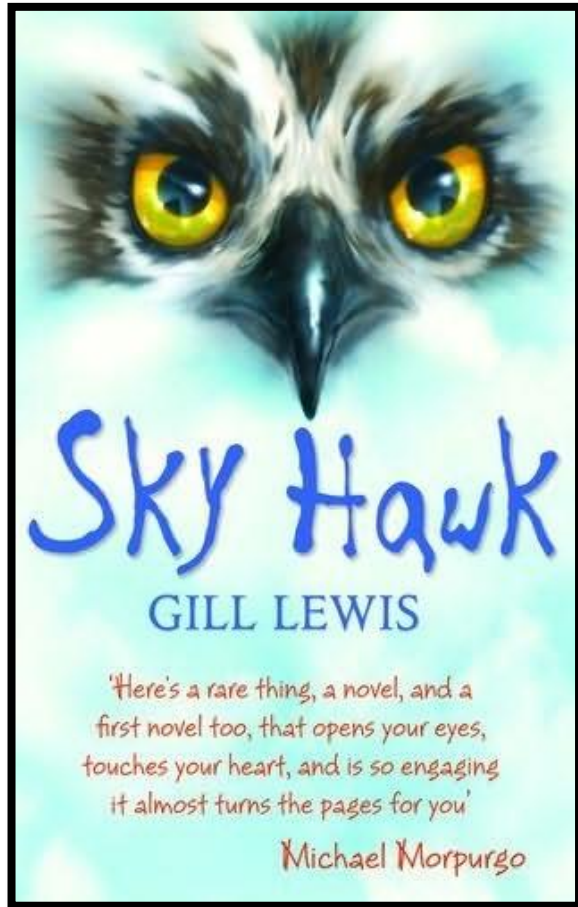
- *Foreshadowing* is the use of hints or clues to suggest what will happen later.
