

In addition to GCSEs, we offer a more personalised curriculum and qualifications of a more vocational nature to those students for whom it is more appropriate.




GCSE Results Compared to National Figures





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Exam Results 2022

This year we have produced a superb set of GCSE results, achieving a Progress 8 score of +0.54. Progress 8 is based on pupils' performance in eight qualifications, including English and mathematics. The average Progress 8 score of all secondary schools nationally is 0. A score of +0.5 or above shows that pupils in that school are achieving 'half a grade higher' in each qualification than other similar pupils nationally.
